Q&A with Brooke Clariday

Orangeburg native Brooke Clariday teaches yoga at the Club, and we hope you'll join her for her future classes. She recently received her RYT®200 certification (a 200-hour, Yoga Alliance instructor training) from My Vinyasa Practice in Austin, Texas. Read on to learn about Brooke's yoga journey and her perspectives on this beneficial, physical activity.



Q: Were you active in your younger years?

A: I have always enjoyed purposeful movement. Throughout my childhood and teenage years, I was a competitive gymnast, took dance classes, and cheered for Orangeburg Prep.

Q: How did you become interested in yoga?

A: When I went to college, I wanted to remain active, so I signed up for a semester of yoga without knowing anything about the practice.

Q: Considering your background, was yoga easy for you?

A: Not at first. The poses were challenging. I couldn't figure out the breathing. I wasn't sure I was going to make it through the semester.

Q: How did you overcome those initial difficulties?

A: I stuck with it. The more classes I went to, the better I got. I finally realized that yoga is not a competition or a sport; it's a practice. I didn't need to be "good" at each pose; I just needed to be present and aware of my body. By the end of that semester, I was hooked! That was 15 years ago, and I've been practicing ever since.

Q: What is your aim for each class?

A: I am excited to share the gift of yoga with members of the Orangeburg Country Club. With each class, my aim is to create a judgment-free and relaxing environment to promote total body wellness.

The Greens Report





October brings weather changes along with changes to the golf course. We have started to winterize the Bermuda by applying fertilizer which strengthens the Bermuda's roots and hardens the plant heading into dormancy. This is just one of the many steps we take going into winter to help the Bermuda survive the cold.

Our pre-emergent applications began in September. We will also make a second application in December. We have to change our program every few years so the weeds that we are trying to control do not develop resistance. By changing timing, products, and using multiple products in one application, helps it prevent resistance from happening.

We are raising the height of cut on all turf areas. The increase in plant material will help the turf survive the winter weather and help reduce the negative impact of cart/equipment traffic when the grass is dormant.

If you ever have any questions or concerns about the golf course or grass in general, please ask. See you on the course!

OCC POLICIES AND EXPECTATIONS

Whether you are a veteran player or out for your first round, it's important to be aware of what is expected, and each club has its own unique policies. **OCC has had an influx of new members** and we predict fall weather to increase play. With that in mind, we have a recap of the Club's etiquette and standards.

- **Stop by the Golf Shop** before you play to sign in and register any guests. Guests are limited to 6 visits per year, regardless of the member who accompanies or sponsors them.
- All play should begin from **#1 tee**, unless directed to start elsewhere by the Golf Shop staff.
- **Groups of less than 3 players** will be paired with others to make groups of 3 or 4. Pairing groups is at the sole discretion of the Golf Shop staff. Requests to "play alone" cannot be accommodated during periods of high traffic.
- **OCC provides a full-service food** and beverage offering, therefore all outside food, beverages and coolers are strictly prohibited. Please inform all guests of this policy prior to their arrival.
- Use the **sand provided on carts** to fill divots.
- **Repair all ball marks** on the greens.
- **Rake the bunkers** for the next player who lands in the hazard. Most golf courses, including OCC, do not rake their bunkers on a daily basis.
- **The fenced area between #2 and #7** contains very soft and deep mud. For your safety and cleanliness, please do not enter this area to retrieve a ball.
- **Keep things moving by:**
 - » Allowing all faster groups (not just smaller groups) to play through
 - » **Call in your food order from the course.** Snack Bar phone numbers are provided on the tee signs at holes 8 and 17, as well as on the golf carts. All food is freshly prepared at the time when it is ordered.

Thank you for your cooperation with these policies. Being on the same page makes your golf experience and others' play most pleasant.





