The Greens Report


Sustained daytime temperatures in the 80s and nighttime temps in the 60s are perfect spring conditions for Bermuda grass. Mother Nature, however, has not cooperated so far this season. My staff and I will continue to monitor the weather and do all we can to optimize grass growth.

I am happy to report that the greens are healing in the spots damaged by cold winter weather. To continue the greens' progress, we will fertilize and conduct extra cultural practices. We will also adjust the edges of a few greens to restore proper drainage.



BRAGGING RIGHTS!

It is often said that The Masters doesn't begin until the back 9 on Sunday. The same thing could have been said about this year's Blue-Red Matches played the weekend before The Masters on April 2-3. After playing the 6-6-6 format on Saturday, which featured 6 holes of Best Ball, 6 holes of Scramble, and 6 holes of Modified Alternate Shot, Team Blue held a slim 11-10 lead over Team Red. Going into Sunday's Single Matches, 42 points were up for grabs in the Nassau-style format with 1 point for the front nine, 1 point for the back nine, and 1 point for the 18-hole total, so the matches were far from over.

After all competitors had played the front 9, the Matches were tied at 17.5 points each. However, Team Blue pulled ahead on the back 9 to win the Blue-Red matches for the 2nd consecutive time, 33.5 – 29.5, as there were no matches in 2020-2021 due to the pandemic. Originally started in 1923, this is the 6th playing of the Blue-Red Matches in the modern era, with Team Blue leading the series with 3 wins, 2 losses, and 1 tie.
