The Greens Report

It's August, which means our Fairway, Tee, Approach, and Greens aerification is complete. We used solid tines on all Tees/Fairways/Approaches this year so heal time was shorter than normal. All of our cultural practices are performed to ensure the health, consistency, and long term success with these greens. Champion ultra-dwarf is a very aggressive thatch/organic matter producing plant. We have to be just as aggressive removing the thatch and diluting organic material. The cultural practices are a necessary evil to have the playing conditions we all expect. Our goal is to have these areas healed as fast as we can so play is not disrupted.


The rough height has been raised to 1.25 inches. We started the season at .75 inch; it was later adjusted to 1 inch in June. We will end the season sometime in late September early October at 1.5 inches. Cart traffic and normal maintenance traffic on dormant Bermuda grass can cause the turf to get thin and matted down. This can result in the turf coming out of dormancy late and promote a good environment for weeds. By increasing the rough length, this will help prevent this from happening. We are always planning for seasons ahead. What we do now effects the course conditions for the fall, winter, and spring seasons.


