The Greens Report


Wow, the year is half over but our growing season is just getting started. After a cool spring, the weather in June was great for growing Bermuda. The nighttime temperatures are in the low 70s and the daytime temperatures are in the mid to upper 90s.

July brings our aerification on the Fairways, Tees, and Approaches the week of July 18. The second greens aerification will be July 25 and 26. These cultural practices are a major part of our overall program for the healthiest turf and best playing conditions possible.


We will start the month by mowing the rough height at 1" and by the end on the month the height will be 1.25". So far this year the rough has been healthy and growing vigorously while we keep the height at a manageable/playable level.
