The Greens Report

It's hard to believe 2022 is coming to a close. Along with all the Club festivities this time of year, December also brings a host of winter projects to the golf course.

Because we didn't experience any challenges with the growing season last winter, the Bermuda is in really good shape going into the winter. The growing season lasted well into November this year and has been exceptional for the course.

Since summer temperatures crept into November, we did experience some weed challenges in a few areas well past the normal windows. To mitigate any issues, we based our weed control program on past weather patterns and longevity of products.

In addition, we've changed our winter pre-emergent program back to one that succeeded in the past. This program requires a split application -- one application in October/November and a second application in the December/January time frame.

Other winter projects this month include drainage work and cart path repair. Although we will work on these projects throughout the winter months, most are out of the way. For the few projects in playing areas, we will take every precaution not to impact play.

I want to wish everyone a safe and happy holiday season! If you ever have any questions about the golf course or your own yard, don't hesitate to call me. See you on the course!

ONLINE TEE TIMES & PAIRINGS OF SINGLES/TWOSOMES

Online tee times are a convenient and fast way of reserving a time at the course. When making an online tee time for a single or twosome, please look at the tee times that are close to your desired time and see if you can fill out a foursome. If a pair of twosomes are back-to-back on the sheet, the Golf Staff will pair the twosomes when they arrive at the course. On one busy day this week, there are 3 twosomes within 40 minutes of each other, all holding a tee time. Not only does this unnecessarily waste tee times, but the pace of play is also not compatible as the twosomes will be much faster than the groups ahead. Everyone's help in making the tee sheet more efficient is greatly appreciated.

Even if not using the online tee time system, groups of less than 4 will be paired at the discretion of the Golf Shop.



LEARNING THE BASICS — TWO-BOUNCE AND NON-VOLLEY ZONE RULES

Last month, we discussed the serving sequence. In this issue, we talk about two common rules – the two-bounce and non-volley zone.

Volleying the ball simply means you hit the ball before it bounces on the court. In pickleball, you cannot volley until the ball has bounced twice after a serve.

So, when the server serves the ball, the receiving team must let it bounce before they return the serve. Then, the serving team must also let the returned serve bounce before hitting it back to the receiving team. The ball must bounce once on each side of the court before players can volley.

The non-volley zone rule prohibits volleying in the "kitchen" part of the court. The kitchen refers to the seven-foot area on both sides of the net.

This rule prevents players from smashing the ball when so close to the net and helps extend rallies. You can play within the kitchen zone, just not volley.


Any rule violation results in a fault and play stops. For example, if you volley the ball and step in the kitchen, you incur a fault. It's a fault even if you step on the line or anything you're wearing or carrying touches the non-volley zone.

If the receiving team faults, the serving team receives a point. A fault by the serving team means the server loses the serve.

In terms of line calls, a serve falling within the non-volley zone or on the non-volley zone line is a fault. A ball can hit any part of any line and is considered within bounds, except for the non-volley zone line on a serve.
