### THE GREENS REPORT

March means spring is in the air! It also marks the beginning of the season for the golf course staff. With the growing season right around the corner, we will begin preparing the turf. Since the turf has endured an up and down winter season, we're looking forward to an early spring.

To prepare for the season, we will apply fertilizer, pre-emergent, and fungicide. The fertilizer applications will carry the first of two pre-emergent applications. The fungicide applications will fight against summer disease. The best defense against these diseases is to stop them before they occur.


With the fluctuating temperatures we had this winter, the greens are susceptible to cold weather damage. We have taken every precaution to protect the greens. To get a sneak peek at what we might face this spring, we cut plugs out of a few greens and brought them inside so they can break dormancy. Although the plugs have been a little slow in breaking dormancy, once they do everything will be fine.




