Guest Rounds

Once a guest has reached the six-visit limit, the guest will need to obtain an OCC membership or wait until the next year when the guest count resets.

Regrip your Clubs

If you didn't get the new driver or set of irons you wanted for Christmas, do the next best thing: get your clubs regripped. According to a 2020 article on Golf.com, you should have your clubs regripped every 40 rounds (a practice session counts like a round), or once a year. Dirt, sweat, heat and humidity can all contribute to the breakdown of your grips. You would never wait until the tires of your car are slick and worn to replace them. But many golfers wait until their grips are in those conditions before changing them which may add unnecessary strokes to one's score.



Grips vary in materials, textures, firmness, and price. Choose the one that best suits your game and your needs. Our grip prices range from \$6.50 to \$14 per club for most grips, which includes installation. Most Putter grips are \$12 - \$29. Stop by the golf shop to discuss your options.

I want to thank everyone for their patience and understanding when we perform our weekly, monthly, and yearly cultural practices. Performing these necessary evils ensures the high-quality playing surface we all expect.

DRESS CODE

General Dress Code

The Orangeburg Country Club expects both men and women to dress in proper golf attire. Men and boys (beginning at age 10) must wear shirts with collars – no tee shirts. Golf shorts (just above the knee) are permitted for men and women. Short shorts, jogging shorts, bike shorts, athletic shorts, coaching shorts, cut off jeans, tank top shirts, halter tops, and swim suits are not permitted in the Clubhouse, on the golf course, or elsewhere on the Club premises. Blue jeans with no visible rips are allowed in the dining room. Exceptions are the appropriate

attire for swimming and tennis complexes; however, such attire is restricted to those areas.

Blackwater Grille

General dress code applies. Caps and hats are prohibited for gentlemen.

Clubhouse Bar

Golf and tennis attire are permitted in the Bar. Swimming attire is not allowed in the Bar.

Tennis Attire

Accepted tennis clothing and shoes are required. Prohibited clothing includes shoes not made specifically for wear

on tennis courts, blue jeans, ragged sweat suits, cut-off jeans, etc. Shirts without collars are acceptable.

Swim Complex

Appropriate swimming attire is required. Please remember that swim attire cannot be worn other places on the Club premises. It is important to have shirts and shoes to wear elsewhere on the Club premises.
